Question Paper Pattern

Level 1 – School Round

- **Total Questions:** 50 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)
- **Question Type:** Single Correct Answer
- **Marks per Question:** 2
- **Maximum Marks:** 100
- **Negative Marking:** No negative marking
- **Duration:** 60 Minutes

JPO Level-2 Qualification Criteria:

To qualify for the JPO Level-2 Examination, a student must achieve a rank within the Top 10% of participants from his/her respective class in the same school, based on the JPO Level-1 Examination results.

Only students meeting this criterion will be eligible to appear for the JPO Level-2 Examination.

Level 2 – National Final Round

- Only students who qualify in **Level 1** will be eligible to appear for **Level 2**.
- The **question paper pattern and examination guidelines** for Level 2 will be announced along with the **Level 1 results**.
- Level 2 will be designed to assess students' **conceptual understanding, logical reasoning, analytical thinking, and problem-solving skills** in Physics.
